Fourteenth Settlement Under Stark Self-Referral Disclosure Protocol

On November 6, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) announced its fourteenth settlement under the Voluntary Self-Referral Disclosure Protocol (SRDP). This settlement involved violations of the federal physician self-referral statute (commonly known as the Stark Law) by a California hospital (Hospital). The Hospital disclosed under the SRDP that it violated the Stark Law by not satisfying the requirements of the physician recruitment exception. The Hospital's violations were settled for \$28,000. CMS provides a <u>list</u> of "select" self-disclosures resolved under the SRDP, including this settlement.
